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# Taiwan Sustainable Development Goals



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- A total of 18 core goals.
- The goal was formulated with reference to the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals, which marked with \* as Taiwan's unique goal.

# Goal 1: Strengthen social care services and economic security for the disadvantaged

Target 1.1 Enhance the self-support rate of the financially vulnerable.

Target 1.2 Constantly promote social assistance to take care of low-income households and middle-low-income households and to relieve those in need of emergency aid or disaster relief; and assist them in achieving self-sufficiency.

Target 1.3 Optimize the coverage of all citizens, particularly the vulnerable, in the insurance system, such as the Labor Insurance, the National Health Insurance, and National Pension; enrich the long-term care system; enhance resources deployment and service provision; and constantly provide living assistance for the senior citizens, children, and youth in the vulnerable group.

Target 1.4 Enhance the protection and equality of all citizens, particularly the vulnerable, those impaired, in starting business, employment, loan, financing, housing, and land ownership.

Target 1.5 Reduce the losses caused by various disasters, and in particular, protect the vulnerable and the low-income groups.

Target 1.a Expand the scale of the plans to promote employment and to end poverty for low-income households and middle-low-income households.



## Goal 2 Ensure food security, eradicate hunger and promote sustainable agriculture

Target 2.1 Ensure all nations have access to safe, nutritious and sufficient food.

Target 2.2 Address the nutritional needs of at all stages in the life cycle.

Target 2.3 Raise agricultural productivity and incomes of farmers through providing secure and equal access to land, productive resources and inputs, knowledge, financial services, markets and value-adding mechanisms.


Target 2.4 Ensure sustainable food production systems and implement agricultural practices that are resilient to climate change by progressively improving land and soil quality, maintaining ecosystems, and enhancing the qualities of agricultural production.

Target 2.5 Maintain the genetic diversity of seeds, cultivated plants and domesticated animals and their related wild species in compliance with international standards by sharing the benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources and associated traditional knowledge as prescribed by international agreements.

Target 2.a Increase investment, including through enhanced international cooperation, in rural infrastructure, agricultural research and extension services, technology development and plant and livestock gene banks.

Target 2.b Eliminate improper trade interferences and subsidy measures in accordance with the mandate of the Doha Development Round.

Target 2.c Strengthen market transaction functions and optimize the transaction system.



## Goal 3 Ensure promote healthy lives and promote well-being for all at all ages

Target 3.1 Reduce maternal mortality ratio.

Target 3.2 Reduce neo-natal and under-5 mortality rate.

Target 3.3 Reduce the incidence rates of AIDS, tuberculosis, and acute hepatitis B; maintain zero indigenous cases of malaria; reduce the fatality rate of dengue fever.

Target 3.4 Reduce cancer, liver cancers and chronic liver disease, cardiovascular disease, chronic respiratory disease and premature death from it, and suicide rate, and promote the healthy lifestyle to citizens.

Target 3.5 Strengthen the prevention and treatment of substance abuse, including narcotic drug abuse and harmful use of alcohol.

Target 3.6 Reduce the number of deaths and injuries from road traffic accidents.

Target 3.7 Promote reproductive health.

Target 3.8 Achieve universal health coverage and sustainability.

Target 3.9 Reduce threats to people's health caused by air, water, and other types of pollution.

Target 3.a Reduce smoking rate.

Target 3.b Strengthen the capacity for implementing International Health Regulations, carrying out health emergency preparedness, and the management of health risks.



## Goal 4 Ensure inclusive and equitable quality education and promote lifelong learning opportunities for all

Target 4.1 Ensure that all girls and boys by the age of 15 complete free, equitable, and quality basic compulsory education leading to relevant and effective learning outcomes.

Target 4.2 Provide communities with new types of public educare services, expand the convenience and accessibility of public educare, increase the opportunities for children to enter kindergarten, and ensure and assist children in accepting educare services.

Target 4.3 Ensure all youth and adults have opportunities to accept equal, affordable and quality higher education.

Target 4.4 Enhance youth's obtainment of information and communications technology (ICT) skills, and increase the opportunities of youth to gain relevant professional techniques and vocational skills.

Target 4.5 Ensure disadvantaged groups obtain education at all levels as well as vocational training, including persons with physical or mental disabilities, indigenous peoples, and disadvantaged children.

Target 4.6 Establish diverse lifelong learning paths, such as community colleges, provide various learning opportunities for adults, and offer people and multi-ethnic groups continuous educational services to enhance adult participation in lifelong learning.

Target 4.7 Promote the MOE Medium-term Program of Human Rights and Civics, activate and integrate civic education, human rights education, and gender equality education into courses by increasing teachers' knowledge of the aforementioned topics, and accelerate paths for students to participate in public affairs. Establish professional qualified educational environments and facilities, continuously promote policies related to various cultures, diverse development, and cultural accessibility to ensure students master the required knowledge and skills of sustainable development promotion.

Target 4.a Establish and enhance the Internet information environment in primary schools, junior high schools, and senior high schools, and provide students with physical or mental disabilities with the required facilities to provide efficient learning.

Target 4.b In order to enhance the education quality and to increase the number of qualified teachers, the amount of teachers who participate in teacher cultivation is maintained every year.

# Goal 5 Achieve gender equality and empower all women and girls

Target 5.1 Reduce the sex ratio at birth.

Target 5.2 Reduce the proportion of women subjected to physical, sexual or psychological violence by a current or former intimate partner in the previous 12 months.<sup>[1]</sup>

Target 5.3 Amend the minimum legal age for marriage of women to 18, and reduce the proportion of marriage registration of women under the legal age for marriage

Target 5.4 Reduce the gap between time spent on unpaid domestic chores and care work by women and their spouses(including partners).

Target 5.5 Encourage government departments of all levels to advance and promote female supervisors and heads; encourage political parties to empower and facilitate women's participation in politics; increase the proportion of female police officers and female managers of listed companies; and guide and encourage women to be enterprise representatives.

Target 5.6 Study and discuss the amendment to the Genetic Health Act and enhance women's self-determination.



<sup>1</sup> Target 5.2: This item includes the violence prevalent and the proportion of women suffering from sexual assault from people other than their partners in coordination with the UN SDG and its corresponding indicators. However, due to Taiwan's social situations and research limitations, the large-scale survey on the violence prevalent on women by intimate partners is only performed on women aged between 18-74 once every four years to demonstrate the violence prevalent on women by intimate partners in Taiwan. Data regarding the proportion of women in Taiwan receiving sexual violence are subject only to statistics on sexual assault (rape) reports accepted by the municipal and county (city) governments.

## Goal 6 Ensure environmental quality and sustainable management of environmental resources

Target 6.1 Supply adequate quantity of quality water and tap water to achieve water safety.

Target 6.2 Achieve public toilet cleaning management to enhance the proportion of public toilets with “distinction” in the evaluation to over 80%.

Target 6.3 Improve the living hygiene of citizens by optimizing river water quality; enhance the implementation of sewage and wastewater treatment; enhance water reusability and reduce the demand for tradition resources development through the innovative use of secondary effluents from public sewage treatment plants; tighten the audit and control of industrial wastewater discharge and track down suspicious pollution sources to stop water quality pollution; optimize river water quality to protect the national health and maintain the ecosystem; and strengthen the chemical flow tracking to improve management performance.

Target 6.4 Promote water conservation and enhance water efficiency to reduce substantial increase in average water consumption; encourage the water recycling rate of industrial park enterprises; enhance the process water recycling rate of science park enterprises; and ensure no substantial annual increase in freshwater withdrawals by enhancing water conservation and diversifying water sources, such as water reclamation and seawater desalination.

Target 6.5 Implement integrated water resources management.

Target 6.6 Constantly implement river integrated governance to maintain environment landscaping and habitat building at the same time; maintain a weighted average Carlson trophic state index (CTSI) below 45, effective capacity of Taiwan’s 20 major reservoirs; implement the periodic quality check of the quality of sediment of rivers, lakes, reservoirs, and irrigational channels across the country to progressively build the sediment quality database; accelerate polluted site improvement to ensure the sustainable use of soil and groundwater resources and protect public health; and encourage enterprises and

groups to adopt coastal areas for enterprises to love Earth and fulfill their corporate social responsibility.

**Target 6.a** Constantly assist developing countries in promoting plans to improve local water and sanitation conditions (same as Target 17.4).

**Target 6.b** Constantly promote community participation and encourage citizens to report pollution, clean up mess, and implement river watch.

**Target 6.c** Improve air quality to protect public health.

**Target 6.d** Further reduction of general waste and promote resource recycling.

**Target 6.e** Enhance recycling of industrial waste for proper waste disposal; implement total quantity control in science parks to guide park enterprises to reduce waste production and enhance waste recycling.




## Goal 7 Ensure access to affordable, reliable, sustainable and modern energy for all

Target 7.1 Ensure universal access to energy services and increase the proportion of generation with clean fuels.

Target 7.2 Increase the installed capacity of renewable energy.

Target 7.3 Tighten compulsory energy conservation by regulating the energy consumption coverage and reduce energy intensity.



# Goal 8 Promote sustained, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, full and productive employment, and decent work

Target 8.1 Sustain appropriate economic growth with innovation, employment, and distribution as core values.

Target 8.2 Increase the value addition of industries and promote the high-value development of the IoT and digital economy.

Target 8.3 Provide credit guarantees or financial assistance and encourage the engagement in the green economy, innovation, and development of micro-, small- and medium-sized enterprise.

Target 8.4 Capture the consumption of key materials, include them in the sustainable management of subsidence lifecycle, and promote the sustainable use of materials (same as Target 12.2).

Target 8.5 Enhance labor productivity.

Target 8.6 Realize knowledge-action integration and training to strengthen youth employability.

Target 8.7 Promote work environment safety and protect the right to participation in labor unions of women workers.

Target 8.8 Promote the sustainable development of tourism, guide the tourism industry to provide green, local travel; and build an environment for sustainable development of tourism and enhance its industrial value in Taiwan (same as Target 12.b).

Target 8.9 Encourage fintech innovation to provide convenient, efficient, and diversified financial services.

Target 8.10 Enhance the water efficiency of industry and agriculture through the water conservation, recycling and reclamation technologies and measures.

Target 8.11 Promote fair prices for water and electricity to reflect the external cost of resource uses.

Target 8.12 Build smart and integrated power grids to enhance power supply quality and power operation efficiency.

Target 8.13 Develop green energy technologies, enhance energy self-determination and energy diversity, and encourage the renewable energy development.



## Goal 9 Build affordable, safe, environmentally friendly, resilient and sustainable transportation

- Target 9.1 Increase passenger volume of buses, railway and high speed rail.
- Target 9.2 Increase the proportion of households in rural areas which can access bus service within 500 meters.
- Target 9.3 Increase the proportion of barrier-free public transportation and relevant equipment and facilities.
- Target 9.4 Reduce the number of traffic fatalities.
- Target 9.5 Reduce the number of traffic fatalities of young motorcyclists(18-24 yrs).



# Goal 10 Reduce inequality within and among countries

Target 10.1 Growth rates of household income per capita among the bottom 40% of the population higher than the total population.

Target 10.2 Constantly implement the plan to promote employment of indigenous peoples to increase job opportunities and incomes for indigenous peoples; and improve the employment for people with disabilities to enhance their financial status.

Target 10.3 Strengthen education and publicity on gender equality and eliminating employment discrimination; build well-established systems for sexual violence prevention and children and youth protection to enhance the public's awareness of discrimination and violence.

Target 10.4 Promote social security measures to take care of the financially vulnerable, strengthen employability, promote wage growth and tax equality, and constantly improve income distribution.

Target 10.5 Facilitate orderly, safe, regular, and responsible immigration and mobility of people, including through the implementation of planned and well-managed migration policies..

Target 10.6 Optimize the capacity of operating social innovation, discover diversified social innovation models, build a friendly ecosystem for social enterprises, and help resolve social problems.

Target 10.a Constantly help developing countries engage in development with Taiwan's advantages and grant them special and differential treatment according to World Trade Organization agreements, and improve preferential treatment, such as tariff-free and quota-free market access, for least developed countries (LDCs) (same as Target 17.6).



# Goal 11 Make cities and human settlements inclusive, safe, resilient and sustainable

- Target 11.1 Ensure access for all to adequate, safe and affordable housing and basic services and upgrade slums.
- Target 11.2 Provide access to safe, affordable, accessible and sustainable transport systems for all, improving road safety, notably by expanding public transport, with special attention to the needs of those in vulnerable situations, women, children, persons with disabilities and older persons.
- Target 11.3 Promote inclusive, sustainable and full participatory cities and human settlement planning and management.
- Target 11.4 Strengthen efforts to protect Taiwan's cultural heritage, natural heritage and the human landscapes that contain the collective memories and historical tracks of people.
- Target 11.5 Reduce the losses caused by various disasters, and in particular, protect the vulnerable and the low-income groups.
- Target 11.6 Reduce the adverse environmental impact of cities, including by paying special attention to air quality and municipal and other waste management.
- Target 11.7 Provide universal access to safe, inclusive and accessible, green and public spaces, in particular for women and children, older persons and persons with disabilities.
- Target 11.8 Establish national spatial plan and municipality or county (city) spatial plan, promote use efficiency of agricultural and industrial land.
- Target 11.9 Strengthening the Social Safety Nets to ensure social stability, and maintaining public order and security to curb violent crime (same as Target 16.1).
- Target 11.10 Improving the effectiveness of the child protection systems and implementing a zero tolerance policy towards violence to safeguard children and to strengthen the capacity in preventing human trafficking (same as Target 16.2).
- Target 11.11 Popularize giga bit-per-second (Gbps) broad-band network deployment and construction
- Target 11.12 Enhance the efficiency of building energy conservation and carbon reduction.



# Goal 12 Ensure sustainable consumption and production patterns

Target 12.1 Realize the green factory system, promote the cradle-to-cradle (C2C) design concept, encourage enterprises to produce low-carbon products, establish green standards for products and clean production, and actively implement the relocation of polluting factories to industrial parks.

Target 12.2 Capture the consumption of key materials, include them in the sustainable management of subsidence lifecycle and promote the sustainable use of materials (same as Target 8.4).

Target 12.3 Reduce food loss in the production and supply chain and reduce food waste in consumption.

Target 12.4 Reduce waste production with green production, enhance the technical capabilities for the recycling and disposal of waste, promote high-efficiency development of the resources recycling industry, and achieve the management of chemicals and all wastes in accordance with agreed international frameworks.

Target 12.5 Promote cross-sector collaboration chain patterns, integrate energy and resources for effective recycling and reuse, and promote the development of the circulatory economy in Taiwan.

Target 12.6 Encourage companies to adopt sustainable practices and disclose sustainable development information, while ensuring information accuracy and quality.

Target 12.7 Increase green procurements in the public and private sectors.

Target 12.8 Promote eco-friendly and recyclable agriculture to reduce the pollution of soil and water by the waste from and produced by the agricultural process.

Target 12.a Implement plans in relation to sustainable consumption and production and eco-friendly technologies.

Target 12.b Promote the sustainable development of tourism, guide the tourism industry to provide green, local travel; and build an environment for sustainable development of tourism and enhance its industrial value in Taiwan (same as Target 8.8).



## Goal 13 Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts

Target 13.1 Strengthen resilience and adaptive capacity to climate change and reduce vulnerability.

Target 13.2 Implement the stage targets of GHG control.

Target 13.3 Improve sustained education and public literacy on climate change.



# Goal 14 Conserve and sustainably use the marine ecosystems, and prevent the degradation of marine environment

Target 14.1 Reduce marine pollution of all kinds, including nutrients and marine waste pollutions.

Target 14.2 Sustainably manage and protect marine and coastal ecosystems.

Target 14.3 Mitigate and address the impacts of ocean acidification.

Target 14.4 Effectively regulate harvesting and end overfishing, illegal, unreported and unregulated (IUU) fishing, or destructive fishing practices, and endeavor to restore fish stocks to the level for sustainable development.

Target 14.5 Conserve at least 10 percent of coastal and marine areas.

Target 14.6 Eliminate subsidies that contribute to illegal, unreported and unregulated (IUU) fishing.

Target 14.b Policy guidance and protection for small-scale artisanal fishers to marine resources and markets.

Target 14.c Realize the existing regions and international system as specified in the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS).



# Goal 15 Conserve and sustainably use terrestrial ecosystems to ensure the persistence of biodiversity and prevent land

Target 15.1 Protect, maintain and promote the sustainable use of terrestrial and inland freshwater ecosystems.

Target 15.2 Realize the sustainable management of all types of forests, terminal illegal logging, and restore degraded forests.

Target 15.3 Restore degraded land and soil.

Target 15.4 Realize the protection of mountain ecosystems.

Target 15.5 Ensure no deterioration of protected species of flora and fauna or presentation of improvement trends.

Target 15.6 Ensure fair and equitable sharing of the benefits arising from the utilization of genetic resources.

Target 15.7 End poaching and trafficking of protected species of flora and wildlife.

Target 15.8 Take measures to prevent and manage invasive alien species to reduce their impacts.

Target 15.9 Integrate ecosystem and biodiversity values into national and local planning, development processes.



# Goal 16 Promote peaceful and inclusive societies, provide access to justice for all and build effective, accountable inclusive

Target 16.1 Strengthening the Social Safety Nets to ensure social stability, and maintaining public order and security to curb violent crime.(same as Target 11.9).

Target 16.2 Improving the effectiveness of the child protection systems and implementing a zero tolerance policy towards violence to safeguard children and to strengthen the capacity in preventing human trafficking.(same as Target 11.10).

Target 16.3 Strengthen open and transparent implementation of the rule of law.

Target 16.4 Integrate anti-corruption capacity to shape a “zero tolerance of corruption” social norm and implement targeted investigations on high-risk business.

Target 16.5 Constantly open government data and increase the volume of open data uses to enhance administration transparency.

Target 16.6 Constantly promote online participation on public policies and expand and raise the platform awareness and functions to attract the use and support of more people.

Target 16.7 The birth registration rate of newborns under the age of 5 with the nationality of the ROC (based on the birth notification of newborns) is 100% and remains.



# Goal 17 Establish diversified partnerships and work together to advance the vision of sustainability

- Target 17.1 Transfer, popularize, and disseminate eco-friendly technologies to enhance energy efficiency, reduce pollution, and promote resource recycling and re-use.
- Target 17.2 Promote healthcare collaboration programs, help special types of countries (LDCs, small island countries, and African countries) train medical personnel in Taiwan, and provide scholarships for recipients to receive professional training in public health and medicine (medicine, nursing, pharmacy) in Taiwan.
- Target 17.3 Constantly provide scholarships for outstanding students of allied countries (and some developing countries) to study in Taiwan.
- Target 17.4 Constantly assist developing countries in promoting plans to improve local water and sanitation conditions (same as Target 6.a).
- Target 17.5 Implement various technological assistance projects for trade aids.
- Target 17.6 Constantly help developing countries engage in development with Taiwan's advantages and grant them special and differential treatment according to World Trade Organization agreements, and improve favorable treatments, tariff free and quota free, for less developed countries (LDCs) (same as Target 10.a).
- Target 17.7 Constantly implement abnormal plans to end poverty based on the needs of the international community.
- Target 17.8 Actively participate in WTO's discussions and negotiations on trade and environmental issues, strengthen the mutual support of trade and the environment, promote a universal, rules-based, open, non-discriminatory and equitable multilateral trading system.
- Target 17.9 Improve the environmental management and pollution prevention work in development countries with capacity-building with technology or public-private collaboration and collaboration through bilateral and multilateral environmental collaboration plans.
- Target 17.10 Constantly promote instructor training collaboration for Indonesia, Vietnam, Thailand, India, and developing countries to select elite candidates to receive further education in Taiwan.



## Goal 18 Build a nuclear-free homeland

Target 18.1 Promote the decommissioning of nuclear plants by law.

Target 18.2 Constantly implement the selection of “Sites for Establishment of Low-Level Radioactive Waste Final Disposal Facility” and remove the storage facility in Lanyu as quickly as possible.

Target 18.3 Promote the legislation of “Sites for Establishment of High-Level Radioactive Waste Final Disposal Facility” to help nuclear plants to complete decommissioning.

Target 18.4 Enhance safety protection for nuclear facilities.

Target 18.5 Implement social communications on nuclear waste operations and enhance awareness education of the nuclear-free homeland.
